6. Presentation to Soldier's 6
 - a. Very impressed that we sold the amount of tickets that we did for the Spring Flood Run Raffle considering that the day was cancelled by Covid-19
 - b. 387 tickets were sold which translates to \$7,740.00 raised and 100% of that amount is directly being donated to Soldier's 6
 - c. Ryan Sheler (who won the bike) stepped up and donated an additional amount of \$2,260.00!
 - d. With the funds raised from ticket sales and the additional amount that Ryan Sheler donated, a total amount of \$10,000 was donated which will 100% fund a future service dog.
